### GENERAL NOTES TO THE APPLICANTS

#### B.Tech (Handloom & Textile Technology)

#### Qualifying Examination and Eligibility.

Candidates who have passed Diploma in Handloom Technology/Handloom & Textile Technology/Textile Technology / B.Sc. with ancillary subject of Mathematics at B.Sc. level or studied Mathematics at +2 level or any equivalent Diploma as prescribed by Directorate of Technical Education, Government of Tamilnadu are eligible to apply. Candidates who have secured a minimum of 55% aggregate marks in Diploma / Degree are eligible to apply.

#### Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on the merit of percentage of marks obtained by the candidates in Diploma / B.Sc. Degree Programme.

1.	B.Sc Degree holders	Mathematics at +2 level or studied Mathematics as Core or Ancillary subject at B.Sc level.

## 1. Nativity

- ❖ Candidates who have passed **IX, X and Diploma** (or) **XI, XII and B.Sc. Degree** from the states/Union Territories other than Tamilnadu are eligible to apply.
- ❖ Candidates who have passed the above exam in the States other than Tamilnadu need not enclose the Nativity Certificate.
- ❖ Native candidates of any State/Union Territory other than Tamilnadu who have passed any of the above exam or their equivalent examination from schools/College situated in Tamilnadu can also apply.
