**GENERAL NOTES TO THE APPLICANTS**

**B.Tech (Handloom & Textile Technology)**

**Mode of Selection**

1. The selection of candidates will be based on the marks obtained in the prescribed subjects reduced to 200(Mathematics -100, Physics + Chemistry -100) in the qualifying examination.

2. The marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various Boards or Authority shall be equated with the marks obtained by the students in the same subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by the State Board of respective state by adopting the method of normalization (e.g) If the highest mark secured by the student of a State Board in Physics is 100 and the Highest mark secured by a student of any other Board in the same subject is 90 both the highest marks will be considered to be equal to 100. If a student of the other Board secures 60 marks in physics when the first mark in Physics in the same Board is 90, 60 marks will be considered to be equal to 66.66 marks as arrived below.

$$\frac{100 \times 60}{90} = 66.66$$

3. After normalization of marks in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by different Boards, the qualified students shall be merged into a common merit list.

4. In the case of candidates who have qualified from National Boards namely CBSE and ISCE, the highest mark obtained in the relevant subject by the candidates at the National Level alone will be taken into consideration for normalization and not the maximum mark scored at Zonal level..

5. The Other Boards will also be requested to furnish the maximum marks scored in the relevant subjects. In case such marks are not available before the preparation of rank, the maximum marks scored in that Board will be considered as 100%

6. **Qualifying Examinations and Eligibility**

A pass in the HSC/Academic or its equivalent) with a minimum average percentage in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together 50% or above.

**Note** : When the candidate produce grade certificate, they have to provide the actual marks also otherwise only the minimum marks applicable to the grades in the eligible subjects (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and fourth optional subject or equivalent) will be taken into account.

8. **Nativity**
