GENERAL NOTES TO THE APPLICANTS

B.Tech (Handloom & Textile Technology)

Qualifying Examination and Eligibility.

Candidates who have passed Diploma/B.Sc. with ancillary subject of Mathematics at B.Sc. level or studied Mathematics at +2 level or any equivalent Diploma as prescribed by Directorate of Technical Education, Government of Tamilnadu are eligible to apply. Candidates who have secured a minimum of 45% aggregate marks in Diploma / Degree are eligible to apply.

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on the merit of CUET score / percentage of marks obtained by the candidates in Diploma / B.Sc. Degree Programme.

S.No	Criteria	Norms.
1.	B.Sc Degree holders	Mathematics at +2 level or studied Mathematics as Core or Ancillary subject at B.Sc level.
2.	Qualifying period for calculation of minimum Eligibility marks.	Full Time/Part Time/Lateral Entry marks obtained in all Semesters in the qualifying examination for Diploma/B.Sc will be considered for calculation of minimum eligibility marks.
3.	Selection Criteria – Qualifying examination marks – Preparation of merit list.	Full Time/Part Time/Lateral Entry Marks obtained in all Semesters in the qualifying examination for Diploma/B.Sc. to be reduced to 100.
4.	Reservation of seats for B.Sc.	No reservation of seats separately for B.Sc. students. B.Sc. will be considered only after Diploma students have been considered.
5.	Counseling	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Diploma holders to be considered for first phase of counseling➤ B.Sc Degree holders to be considered against unfilled seats.

A minimum of 55.00% of marks is required in the qualifying examination for admission to Second Year BE/B.Tech programme.
